AN ACT

To amend chapter 221, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the transfer of prisoners.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 221, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 221.035, to read as follows:

221.035. 1. Any sheriff or jailer of a jail located in any city not within a county, any county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants, or any home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county shall be provided, by a sheriff or other officer charged with the delivery of a person committed to the jail, the following information regarding the person being delivered:

(1) Information regarding the mental and physical health of the person being delivered while in jail;

(2) All records of any mental and physical health treatment or care the person received while in jail;

(3) All records of any medication the person took while in jail;

(4) If no records listed in subdivision (2) and (3) of this subsection exist, then the sheriff or other officer charged with delivering the person shall certify, in writing, that no such records exist.

2. The information provided pursuant to subsection 1 of this section shall be provided before or at the time of delivery of such person to any jail located in any city not within a county, any county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants, or any home rule city with more than four

23 3. If the information required to be provided pursuant to
24 subsection 1 of this section is not provided to the sheriff or jailer of any
25 jail located in any city not within a county, any county with a charter
26 form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand
27 inhabitants, or any home rule city with more than four hundred
28 thousand inhabitants and located in more than one county, then the
29 sheriff or jailer may refuse to accept the person being delivered.
