# AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to the designation of memorial infrastructure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new 2 sections, to be known as sections 227.800 and 227.801, to read as follows:

227.800. The portion of Interstate 70 in Jackson County from the Blue Ridge Cutoff overpass continuing west to the Troost Avenue overpass shall be designated the "Senator Phil B. Curls Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by private donations.

227.801. The portion of Interstate 70 in the city of St. Louis from the Salisbury Street overpass continuing west to the Goodfellow Boulevard overpass shall be designated the "Senator Paula J. Carter Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by private donations.
