AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the use of radio frequency identification technology in school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 167.168, to read as follows:

167.168. 1. No school district shall require a student to use an

- 2 identification device that uses radio frequency identification
- 3 technology, or similar technology, to identify the student, transmit
- 4 information regarding the student, or monitor or track the location of
- 5 the student.
- 6 2. For purposes of this section, "radio frequency identification
- 7 technology" shall mean a wireless identification system that uses an
- 8 electromagnetic radio frequency signal to transmit data without
- 9 physical contact between a card, badge, or tag and another device.
