## AN ACT

To repeal sections 253.048 and 253.110, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the display of civil war property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 253.048 and 253.110, RSMo, are repealed and two new

- 2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 253.048 and 253.110, to
- 3 read as follows:
  - 253.048. 1. Within the state parks, the department may accompany the
- 2 display of the flag of the United States and the flag of this state with the display
- 3 of the MIA/POW flag, which is designed to commemorate the service and sacrifice
- 4 of members of the Armed Forces of the United States who were prisoners of war
- 5 or missing in action and with the display of the Honor and Remember flag as an
- 6 official recognition and in honor of fallen members of the Armed Forces of the
- 7 United States.
- 8 2. The state of Missouri, or any agency or department thereof,
- 9 shall not sell or display the Battle Flag of the Confederacy, also
- 10 referred to as the Stars and Bars, or any similar image, or tangible
- 11 personal property, inscribed with such an image unless the image
- 12 appears in a book, digital medium, state museum, or state park that
- 13 serves an educational or historical purpose.
  - 253.110. 1. All parts of the following described land situated in Lafayette
  - 2 County, of Missouri, selected and dedicated by the board of trustees of the
  - 3 Confederate Soldiers' Home under an act of the general assembly appearing at
  - 4 Laws 1925, page 136, approved May 2, 1925, to wit: Beginning 2.00 chains east
  - 5 of the S.W. corner of the east ½ of S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 25 T50 R26; thence north 47
  - 6 degrees east 20.00 chains to a stake; thence north 35 ½ degrees west 3.97 chains

to a stake; thence north 50 ½ degrees east 4.84 chains to a post; thence north 39 ½ degrees west 1.54 chains to a stake; thence north 50 ½ degrees east 3.84 chains to an iron post; thence north 35 degrees west 2.15 chains to the south line of the public road; thence north 54 ½ degrees east along the south line of said road 10 15.03 chains to a concrete post on the west line of the public road, running south 11 34 degrees east; thence south 34 degrees east along the west line of said road 1241.03 chains to the south line of Confederate home land; thence west on said last 13 named line 52.85 chains to the beginning, are set apart as a permanent memorial 14 park to the valor of the soldiers who served the Confederacy in the War between 15 16 the States. The land is under the control, maintenance and administration of the department of natural resources and is designated "The Confederate Memorial 17 18 Park".

2. All monuments and plaques owned by the state that commemorate any individual or sovereign entity that engaged in military action against the United States government are ordered transferred and installed in the Confederate Memorial Park, wherein the monuments and plaques shall be located in perpetuity in the custody and under the protection of the department of natural resources.
