AN ACT

To repeal sections 115.277, 115.279, and 115.283, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to absentee voting.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 115.277, 115.279, and 115.283, RSMo, are repealed 2 and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 115.277, 3 115.279, and 115.283, to read as follows:

115.277. 1. Except as provided in subsections 2, 3, 4, and 5 of this section, any registered voter of this state may vote by absentee ballot for all candidates and issues for which such voter [would be] is eligible to vote at the polling place [if such voter expects to be prevented from going to the polls to vote on election day due to:

6 (1) Absence on election day from the jurisdiction of the election authority 7 in which such voter is registered to vote;

8 (2) Incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability, 9 including a person who is primarily responsible for the physical care of a person 10 who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability;

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(3) Religious belief or practice;

(4) Employment as an election authority, as a member of an election
authority, or by an election authority at a location other than such voter's polling
place;

15 (5) Incarceration, provided all qualifications for voting are retained;

16 (6) Certified participation in the address confidentiality program 17 established under sections 589.660 to 589.681 because of safety concerns].

18 2. Any covered voter[, as defined in section 115.275,] who is eligible to

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register and vote in this state may vote in any election for federal office, 19 statewide office, state legislative office, or statewide ballot initiatives by 2021submitting a federal postcard application to apply to vote by absentee ballot or 22by submitting a federal postcard application at the polling place even though the 23person is not registered. A federal postcard application submitted by a covered voter pursuant to this subsection shall also serve as a voter registration 24application under section 115.908 and the election authority shall, if satisfied 2526that the applicant is entitled to register, place the voter's name on the voter 27registration file. Each covered voter may vote by absentee ballot or, upon 28submitting an affidavit that the person is qualified to vote in the election, may 29vote at the person's polling place.

30 3. Any interstate former resident[, as defined in section 115.275,] may
31 vote by absentee ballot for presidential and vice presidential electors.

4. Any intrastate new resident[, as defined in section 115.275,] may vote by absentee ballot at the election for presidential and vice presidential electors, United States senator, representative in Congress, statewide elected officials and statewide questions, propositions and amendments from such resident's new jurisdiction of residence after registering to vote in such resident's new jurisdiction of residence.

5. Any new resident[, as defined in section 115.275,] may vote by absentee
ballot for presidential and vice presidential electors after registering to vote in
such resident's new jurisdiction of residence.

115.279. 1. Application for an absentee ballot may be made by the 2 applicant in person, or by mail, or for the applicant, in person, by his or her 3 guardian or a relative within the second degree by consanguinity or affinity. The 4 election authority shall accept applications by facsimile transmission and by 5 electronic mail within the limits of its telecommunications capacity.

2. Each application shall be made to the election authority of the 6 jurisdiction in which the person is or would be registered. Each application shall 7 be in writing and shall state the applicant's name, address at which he or she is 8 or would be registered, [his or her reason for voting an absentee ballot,] whether 9 the applicant is incapacitated or confined due to illness or physical 10 disability or is a person who is primarily responsible for the physical 11 12care of a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or 13**physical disability**, the address to which the ballot is to be mailed, if mailing is requested, and for absent uniformed services and overseas applicants, the 14

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15applicant's email address if electronic transmission is requested. If the [reason 16 for the applicant voting absentee is due to the reasons established under 17subdivision (6) of subsection 1 of section 115.277] applicant is a certified participant in the address confidentiality program established under 18 sections 589.660 to 589.681, the applicant shall state the voter's identification 19information provided by the address confidentiality program in lieu of the 20applicant's name, address at which he or she is or would be registered, and 21address to which the ballot is to be mailed, if mailing is requested. Each 22application to vote in a primary election shall also state which ballot the 23applicant wishes to receive. If any application fails to designate a ballot, the 2425election authority shall, within three working days after receiving the application, 26notify the applicant by mail that it will be unable to deliver an absentee ballot 27until the applicant designates which political party ballot he or she wishes to receive. If the applicant does not respond to the request for political party 2829designation, the election authority is authorized to provide the voter with that part of the ballot for which no political party designation is required. 30

313. [Except as provided in subsection 3 of section 115.281,] All applications for absentee ballots received prior to the sixth Tuesday before an election shall 32 be stored at the office of the election authority until such time as the applications 33 are processed in accordance with section 115.281. No application for an absentee 34ballot received in the office of the election authority by mail, by facsimile 35 transmission, by electronic mail, or by a guardian or relative after 5:00 p.m. on 36 37 the second Wednesday immediately prior to the election shall be accepted by any 38election authority. No application for an absentee ballot submitted by the applicant in person after 5:00 p.m. on the day before the election shall be 39 40 accepted by any election authority, except as provided in subsections 6, 8 and 9 41 of this section.

424. Each application for an absentee ballot shall be signed by the applicant or, if the application is made by a guardian or relative pursuant to this section, 43the application shall be signed by the guardian or relative, who shall note on the 44 application his or her relationship to the applicant. If an applicant, guardian or 45relative is blind, unable to read or write the English language or physically 46 47incapable of signing the application, he or she shall sign by mark, witnessed by 48the signature of an election official or person of his or her own choosing. Any 49 person who knowingly makes, delivers or mails a fraudulent absentee ballot application shall be guilty of a class one election offense. 50

51 5. (1) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any resident of the state 52 of Missouri who resides outside the boundaries of the United States or who is on 53 active duty with the Armed Forces of the United States or members of their 54 immediate family living with them may request an absentee ballot for both the 55 primary and subsequent general election with one application.

56 (2) The election authority shall provide each absent uniformed services 57 voter and each overseas voter who submits a voter registration application or an 58 absentee ballot request, if the election authority rejects the application or request, 59 with the reasons for the rejection.

60 (3) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, if a standard oath 61 regarding material misstatements of fact is adopted for uniformed and overseas 62 voters pursuant to the Help America Vote Act of 2002, the election authority shall 63 accept such oath for voter registration, absentee ballot, or other election-related 64 materials.

(4) Not later than sixty days after the date of each regularly scheduled 65general election for federal office, each election authority which administered the 66 67 election shall submit to the secretary of state in a format prescribed by the secretary a report on the combined number of absentee ballots transmitted to, 68 69 and returned by, absent uniformed services voters and overseas voters for the election. The secretary shall submit to the Election Assistance Commission a 70 71combined report of such information not later than ninety days after the date of 72each regularly scheduled general election for federal office and in a standardized 73format developed by the commission pursuant to the Help America Vote Act of 742002. The secretary shall make the report available to the general public.

(5) As used in this section, the terms "absent uniformed services voter"
and "overseas voter" shall have the meaning prescribed in 52 U.S.C. Section
20310.

6. An application for an absentee ballot by a new resident shall be submitted in person by the applicant in the office of the election authority in the election jurisdiction in which such applicant resides. The application shall be received by the election authority no later than 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election. Such application shall be in the form of an affidavit, executed in duplicate in the presence of the election authority or any authorized officer of the election authority, and in substantially the following form:

6. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, any covered voter as defined in section 115.902 or persons who have declared themselves to be permanently disabled pursuant to section 115.284, otherwise entitled to vote, shall not be required to obtain a notary seal or signature on his or her absentee ballot.

176 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or section 115.291 to the contrary, the subscription, signature and seal of a notary or other officer 177178authorized to administer oaths shall not be required on any ballot, ballot 179envelope, or statement required by this section if the [reason for the] voter voting absentee is [due to the reasons established pursuant to subdivision (2) of 180subsection 1 of section 115.277] incapacitated or confined due to illness or 181 182physical disability, including a person who is primarily responsible for 183 the physical care of a person who is incapacitated or confined due to 184 illness or physical disability.

185 8. No notary shall charge or collect a fee for notarizing the signature on186 any absentee ballot or absentee voter registration.

9. A notary public who charges more than the maximum fee specified or
who charges or collects a fee for notarizing the signature on any absentee ballot
or absentee voter registration is guilty of official misconduct.
