ANACT

To amend chapter 1, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a federally guaranteed right to vote, with a referendum clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 1, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 1.315, to read as follows:

1.315. The general assembly of this state finds that voting in the
United States of America has traditionally been a right afforded at the
state level and that no explicit right to vote exists in the United States
Constitution. The general assembly and the citizens of this state favor
the addition of an amendment to the United States Constitution that
guarantees every citizen of this country the right to vote.

Section B. This act is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state for approval or rejection at an election which is hereby ordered and which shall be held and conducted on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2016, pursuant to the laws and constitutional provisions of this state for the submission of referendum measures by the general assembly, and this act shall become effective when approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon at such relection and not otherwise.
