JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article XII of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to the modification to the form of local government.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article XII of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article XII, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding 2 thereto one new section, to be known as section 4, to read as follows:

Section 4. If any amendment to this Constitution proposed by the 2 general assembly or by the initiative would directly modify the form of 3 government of one or more counties, cities, or towns, that amendment 4 shall only go into effect if a majority of the qualified electors voting 5 thereon in each county, city, or town that would be affected vote in 6 favor of the amendment.
