4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A NONRESIDENT
5	RELATIVE OF A RESIDENT TO RECEIVE A REDUCED COST HUNTING LICENSE; AMENDING SECTION
6	87-2-514, MCA; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 87-2-514, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"87-2-514. Nonresident relative of resident allowed to purchase nonresident licenses at reduced
12	cost definitions. (1) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions apply:
13	(a) "Nonresident relative of a resident" means a person born in Montana who is the natural or adoptive
14	child, sibling, or parent of a resident but is not a resident.
15	(b) "Resident" means a resident as defined in 87-2-102.
16	(2) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a nonresident relative of a resident who meets the
17	qualifications of subsection (5) may purchase:
18	(a) a Class B nonresident fishing license;
19	(b) a Class B-1 nonresident upland game bird license;
20	(c) a Class B-7 nonresident deer A tag; and
21	(d) a Class B-15 nonresident elk license as provided in 87-2-515.
22	(3) This section does not allow a nonresident relative of a resident to purchase nonresident combination
23	licenses at a reduced price.
24	(4) The fee for a nonresident license purchased pursuant to subsection (2) is four times the amount
25	charged for an equivalent resident license. The nonresident relative of a resident shall also purchase a
26	nonresident wildlife conservation license as prescribed in 87-2-202 and pay the nonresident hunting access
27	enhancement fee in 87-2-202(3)(d) if the nonresident relative of a resident purchases a hunting license.
28	(5) To qualify for a license pursuant to subsection (2), a nonresident relative of a resident shall apply at
29	any department regional office or at the department's state office in Helena and present proof of the following:
30	(a) a birth certificate verifying the applicant's birth in Montana or documentation that the applicant was

1	born to parents who were residents at the time of birth;
2	(b) if applying for a hunting license, evidence that the person previously held a Montana resident hunting
3	<del>or fishing license or</del> has passed a hunter safety course i <del>n Montana</del> pursuant to 87-2-105; and
4	(c) proof that the applicant is a nonresident relative of a resident."
