8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 2-15-2212, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"2-15-2212. Committee on telecommunications access services for persons with disabilities
12	composition allocation. (1) There is a committee on Montana telecommunications access services for
13	persons with disabilities.
14	(2) The committee consists of 13 members appointed by the governor as follows:
15	(a) four members who are persons with disabilities, two of whom must be deaf or hard-of-hearing;
16	(b) two members who are not persons with disabilities, one of whom must be engaged in a business
17	other than a business in the telecommunications industry and one of whom must be a senior citizen;
18	(c) one member from the department of public health and human services;
19	(d) one member from the largest service provider in Montana a public safety answering point, as defined
20	in 10-4-101, who has knowledge of emergency communications issues for individuals who are deaf or
21	hard-of-hearing;
22	(e) one member from an independent service provider;
23	(f) one member from an interLATA interexchange carrier;
24	(g) one member from the public service commission;
25	(h) one member who is a licensed audiologist; and
26	(i) one member from the department of administration.
27	(3) The committee is allocated to the department of public health and human services for administrative
28	purposes only as provided in 2-15-121."
