| 12 | Section 1. Article X, section 9, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read: |
| 13 | "Section 9. Boards of education. (1) There is a state board of education composed of the board of |
| 14 | regents of higher education and the board of public education. It is responsible for long-range planning, and for |
| 15 | coordinating and evaluating policies and programs for the state's educational systems. It shall submit unified |
| 16 | budget requests. A tie vote at any meeting may be broken by the governor, who is an ex officio member of each |
| 17 | component board. |
| 18 | (2) (a) The government and control of the Montana university system is vested in a board of regents of |
| 19 | higher education which shall have full power, responsibility, and authority to supervise, coordinate, manage and |
| 20 | control the Montana university system and shall supervise and coordinate other public educational institutions |
| 21 | assigned by law. |
| 22 | (b) The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor, and confirmed by the senate, to |
| 23 | overlapping terms, as provided by law. The governor and superintendent of public instruction are ex officio |
| 24 | non-voting members of the board. |
| 25 | (c) The board shall appoint a commissioner of higher education and prescribe his term and duties. |
| 26 | (d) The funds and appropriations under the control of the board of regents are subject to the same audit |
| 27 | provisions as are all other state funds. |
| 28 | (3) (a) There is a board of public education to exercise general supervision over the public school system |
| 29 | and such other public educational institutions as may be assigned by law. Other duties of the board shall be |
