A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 OF AN ACT TO REOUIRE THAT THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE HOUSE 3 REPRESENTATIVES ARE BROADCAST TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND TO 4 STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF TELEVISING ALL SESSIONS.

5 Whereas, it is a duty of the North Carolina House of Representatives to provide access 6 to the citizens of the State of North Carolina; Now, therefore,

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 SECTION 1. Internet Broadcast of Sessions. - The North Carolina House of 9 Representatives shall provide the general public with video access of its daily legislative sessions. 10 The General Assembly shall install video equipment in the House of Representatives chamber, 11 an on-site control center to manage all production aspects of recording, and ensure Internet broadcasting of each daily session. The Legislative Services Office shall provide staff to the 12 Information Systems Division (ISD), which shall be responsible for procuring video equipment 13 and implementing the daily video production and broadcast of the House of Representatives' 14 15 daily sessions. ISD shall also archive the video recordings and make such recordings accessible 16 to the public on the General Assembly Web site.

SECTION 2. Televise Selected Sessions. - The University of North Carolina Center 17 18 for Public Television shall broadcast daily sessions of the House of Representatives that are of 19 particular public importance.

20 SECTION 3. Study Televising All Sessions. - There is created the House Select 21 Committee on Televising Legislative Sessions (Committee). The Committee shall study the 22 feasibility of creating a new channel for use by The University of North Carolina Center for 23 Public Television to broadcast all legislative sessions of the House of Representatives.

24 The Committee shall consist of nine members appointed by the Speaker of the House 25 of Representatives. The Speaker shall designate the Chair. The Committee shall meet upon the 26 call of the Chair. A majority shall constitute a quorum of the Committee and no official action 27 may be taken except by a majority vote at a meeting at which a quorum is present. While in the discharge of its official duties, the Committee shall have the powers under G.S. 120-19 and 28 29 G.S. 120-19.1 through G.S. 120-19.4.

30 Members of the Committee shall receive subsistence and travel expenses as provided 31 in G.S. 120-3.1. The Committee may contract for consultants or hire employees in accordance 32 with G.S. 120-32.02. The Legislative Services Commission, through the Legislative Services 33 Officer, shall assign professional staff to assist the Committee in its work. Upon the direction of 34 the Legislative Services Commission, the Supervisor of Clerks of the House of Representatives 35 shall assign clerical staff to the Committee.

1 The Committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the 2019 General 2 Assembly no later than April 20, 2020. The Committee shall terminate upon submission of its 3 report or April 20, 2020, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
