AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN VOTING MACHINES TO CONTINUE IN USE AFTER DECEMBER 1, 2019, IN CERTAIN COUNTIES ONLY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Sections 30.8 and 30.9 of S.L. 2013-381, as amended by Section 6 of S.L. 2015-103 and Section 3.11 of S.L. 2018-13, and notwithstanding G.S. 163A-1111 and G.S. 163A-1115, direct record electronic (DRE) voting systems that do not use paper ballots may be used in any election conducted prior to December 1, 2021, whether or not the direct record electronic (DRE) voting system has been certified or decertified by the State Board of Elections in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. This act applies to Alamance, Brunswick, Burke, Davie, Guilford, and Pamlico counties only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
