A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM REGARDING
THE TIME OF ELECTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 12J of the Charter of the City of Winston-Salem, being Chapter 232 of the Private Laws of 1927, as amended by Section 1(d) of S.L. 2011-141, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 12J. Time of Election; Terms.

- (a) In 2013, 2022, the primary and election for mayor and council members shall be held on the dates provided in G.S. 163-279(a)(2).G.S. 163A-1585(a)(2).
- (b) The terms of the mayor and council members of the City of Winston-Salem elected in 2013-2016 are extended by two years and expire at the organizational meeting after the 2016 2022 regular municipal election.
- (c) Notwithstanding G.S. 163-279, any provision of law to the contrary, the mayor and council members elected in 2016-2022 shall each serve four-year terms, which terms shall expire at the organizational meeting after the 2026 regular municipal election. In 2026, and quadrennially thereafter, primaries and elections for mayor and city council shall be held at the same time as for county officers as provided in G.S. 163-1 as provided by law."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.
