AN ACT TO FUND NATIONAL BOARD FOR PROFESSIONAL TEACHING STANDARDS CERTIFICATION FOR UP TO ONE THOUSAND TEACHERS OVER THE 2019-2021 FISCAL BIENNIUM.

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of nine hundred eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$987,500) in nonrecurring funds for each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium to provide grants to a total of up to 1,000 teachers to cover the full application fee for National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) certification, as follows:

- The Department shall distribute the grants in each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal (1) biennium to teachers who meet the minimum requirements to receive State financial assistance for the NBPTS participation fee under G.S. 115C-296.2.
- Grants shall be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, according to a (2) procedure developed by the Department, beginning no later than September 1 of each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium.
- Teachers receiving grants shall also receive up to three days of approved paid (3) leave in accordance with G.S. 115C-296.2.
- (4) A teacher who receives a grant shall have no obligation to repay the grant to the State even in the event that the teacher does not receive NBPTS certification.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
