(1	The amount paid to the taxpayer during the taxable year from the Sta Emergency Response and Disaster Relief Reserve Fund for hurricane relief assistance, but not including payments for goods or services provided by thaxpayer.
<u>(1</u>	A percentage of income that (i) is earned by an essential employee and (ii) derived from activities for which the employee is deemed essential during the period of March 28, 2020, to December 31, 2020. For purposes of the subdivision, an "essential employee" is an employee working in a critic infrastructure sector identified by the Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency of the United States Department of Homeland Security in the advisor list published on March 28, 2020.
