Section 1. (1) A person who is elected or appointed to 1 2 serve on the governing body of a political subdivision or the governing body of an agency of the executive department of the State 3 4 of Nebraska which is created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by 5 statute, or otherwise pursuant to law, including the Board of Regents 6 of the University of Nebraska, or on an independent board, 7 commission, bureau, committee, council, subunit, or other body 8 created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise pursuant to law is not eligible for employment by the entity for two 9 10 years after leaving such position. 11 (2) A person who appoints a member to serve on the 12 governing body of a political subdivision or the governing body of an 13 agency of the executive department of the State of Nebraska which is created by the Constitution of Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise 14 pursuant to law, including the Board of Regents of the University of 15 16 Nebraska, or on an independent board, commission, bureau, committee, council, subunit, or other body created by the Constitution of 17 Nebraska, by statute, or otherwise pursuant to law is not eligible 18 for employment by the entity for two years after leaving the position 19 20 by virtue of which he or she made the appointment.
