1 Section 1. Section 69-2436, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 69-2436 (1) A permit to carry a concealed handgun is
- 4 valid throughout the state for a period of five years after the date
- 5 of issuance. The fee for issuing a permit is one hundred dollars.
- 6 $\frac{(2)-(2)(a)}{(2)}$ The Nebraska State Patrol shall renew a
- 7 person's permit to carry a concealed handgun for a renewal period of
- 8 five years, subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of
- 9 section 69-2433. , except as provided in subsection (4) of section
- 10 69-2443.
- 11 (b) The permit of any person serving on active duty,
- 12 <u>other than members of the National Guard or reserves activated for</u>
- 13 training purposes only, outside the State of Nebraska as a member of
- 14 the United States Armed Forces, or the spouse of any such person or a
- 15 dependent of such member of the armed forces, shall be valid during
- 16 <u>such person's period of active duty and for not more than sixty days</u>
- 17 immediately following such person's date of separation from service,
- 18 subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of section
- 19 69-2433.
- 20 (3) The renewal fee is fifty dollars, and renewal may be
- 21 applied for up to four months before expiration of a permit to carry
- 22 a concealed handgun.
- 23 $\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ The applicant shall submit the <u>renewal</u> fee with
- 24 the application to the Nebraska State Patrol. The fee shall be
- 25 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska State

- 1 Patrol Cash Fund.
- 2 (5) Each individual who is applying for renewal of his or
- 3 her permit shall submit his or her previous license to the department
- 4 personnel or, when the previous license is unavailable, furnish proof
- 5 of identification in accordance with section 60-484.
- (4) On or before June 30, 2007, the Nebraska State
- 7 Patrol shall journal entry, as necessary, all current fiscal year
- 8 expenses and revenue, including investment income, from the Public
- 9 Safety Cash Fund under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act and recode
- 10 them against the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund and its program
- 11 appropriation.
