- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to transportation network companies; to amend section 75-326, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to transfer a compliance provision and eliminate safety inspection provisions relating to the use of personal vehicles; to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal section 75-328, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 75-326, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 75-326 (1) A participating driver must possess a valid driver's
- 4 license, proof of registration, and proof of automobile liability
- 5 insurance and be at least twenty-one years of age.
- 6 (2) Prior to permitting a person to act as a driver, the
- 7 transportation network company shall obtain and review a national
- 8 criminal history record information check. The criminal disposition
- 9 information retrieved by the transportation network company's national
- 10 criminal history record information check shall be at least as
- 11 comprehensive as the criminal disposition information retrieved by a
- 12 national criminal history record information check performed by the
- 13 Federal Bureau of Investigation pursuant to section 81-6,120. Nothing in
- 14 this subsection shall be construed to require fingerprinting as part of
- 15 the national criminal history record information check.
- 16 (3) A person who has four or more moving traffic violations or one
- 17 or more major traffic violations in the three years prior to the date of
- 18 the criminal background check shall not serve as a driver. For purposes
- 19 of this subsection, the following offenses shall constitute major traffic
- 20 violations:
- 21 (a) Failure to stop and report or render aid as required under
- 22 section 60-696 or 60-697;
- 23 (b) Reckless driving in violation of any city or village ordinance
- 24 or of section 60-6,213, 60-6,214, or 60-6,217;
- (c) Speeding of more than thirty-five miles per hour over the speed
- 26 limit; and
- 27 (d) Failure to yield to a pedestrian resulting in bodily injury to a
- 28 pedestrian.
- 29 (4) A person who has been convicted of or pled guilty or nolo
- 30 contendere to driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol in the
- 31 previous seven years in this state or any other state or territory prior

- 1 to the date of the criminal background check shall not serve as a driver.
- 2 (5) A person who is required to register as a sex offender or who
- 3 has been convicted of or pled guilty or nolo contendere to any offense
- 4 involving fraud, use of a motor vehicle to commit a felony, a crime
- 5 involving property damage, theft, acts of violence, or acts of terror
- 6 shall not serve as a driver.
- 7 (6) In order to be used under sections 75-323 to 75-343, a personal
- 8 <u>vehicle shall be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Registration Act as</u>
- 9 required for a passenger car as defined in section 60-345.
- 10 Sec. 2. Original section 75-326, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 11 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 12 Sec. 3. The following section is outright repealed: Section 75-328,
- 13 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
