Section 1. Section 77-2712.03, Revised Statutes
 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3 77-2712.03 (1) The streamlined sales and use tax 4 agreement, as adopted by the streamlined sales tax implementing 5 states on November 12, 2002, including amendments through December 6 31, 2010, is hereby ratified by the Legislature. The Governor shall 7 enter into the agreement with one or more states to simplify and 8 modernize sales and use tax administration in order to substantially reduce the burden of tax compliance for all sellers and for all types 9 of commerce. In furtherance of the agreement, the Department of 10 Revenue is authorized to act jointly with other states that are 11 12 members under Articles Article VII or VIII of the agreement to 13 establish standards for certification of a certified service provider 14 and certified automated system and establish performance standards 15 for multistate sellers. The department is further authorized to take other actions permissible under law reasonably required to implement 16 the provisions set forth in the agreement. Other actions authorized 17 by this section include, but are not limited to, the adoption and 18 19 promulgation of rules and regulations and the joint procurement, with 20 other member states, of goods and services in furtherance of the 21 agreement.

1 Council are authorized to represent Nebraska before the other member 2 states under the agreement. The state also agrees to participate in 3 and comply with the procedures of and decisions made by the governing 4 board of the member states. These provisions of the agreement include 5 the creation of the organization as provided in Article VII of the б agreement, the requirements for state entry and withdrawal as 7 provided in Article VIII of the agreement, amendments to the 8 agreement as provided in Article IX of the agreement, and a dispute 9 resolution process as provided in Article X of the agreement.
