- FOR AN ACT relating to social workers; to amend sections 28-310,
 38-2101, and 38-2128, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska; to change penalties relating to assault in the
 third degree; to provide requirements for safety
 awareness training; to harmonize provisions; and to
 repeal the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-310, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-310 (1) A person commits the offense of assault in the
- 4 third degree if he or she:
- 5 (a) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causes bodily
- 6 injury to another person; or
- 7 (b) Threatens another in a menacing manner.
- 8 (2) Assault in the third degree shall be a Class I
- 9 misdemeanor, except that (a) assault in the third degree on a social
- 10 worker acting in his or her official capacity is a Class IV felony
- 11 and (b) assault in the third degree unless—committed in a fight or
- 12 scuffle entered into by mutual consent, in which case it shall be is
- 13 a Class II misdemeanor.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 38-2101, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 15 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 16 38-2101 Sections 38-2101 to 38-2139 and section 4 of this
- 17 act shall be known and may be cited as the Mental Health Practice
- 18 Act.
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 38-2128, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 20 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 21 38-2128 (1) A person shall be qualified to be a certified
- 22 master social worker if he or she:
- 23 (a) Has a doctorate or a master's degree in social work
- 24 from an approved educational program;
- 25 (b) Has had a minimum of at least three thousand hours of

1 experience, in addition to the master's or doctorate degree, in

- 2 social work under the supervision as defined in section 38-2127 of a
- 3 certified master social worker;
- 4 (c) Provides evidence to the department that he or she
- 5 meets the requirements of subdivisions (1)(a) and (1)(b) of this
- 6 section and has completed no fewer than six hours of social worker
- 7 <u>safety awareness training;</u> and
- 8 (d) Completes an application and satisfactorily passes an
- 9 examination approved by the board.
- 10 (2) A person shall be qualified to be a certified social
- 11 worker if he or she provides evidence to the board that he or she has
- 12 a baccalaureate or master's degree in social work from an approved
- 13 educational program and has completed no fewer than six hours of
- 14 <u>social worker safety awareness training</u> and completes an application
- 15 form.
- 16 Sec. 4. On and after January 1, 2012, in addition to the
- 17 requirements of section 38-146, an applicant for renewal of
- 18 certification as a certified social worker or a certified master
- 19 social worker shall complete no fewer than six hours of social worker
- 20 <u>safety awareness training if such applicant has not previously</u>
- 21 presented evidence to the department that he or she has completed
- 22 <u>such social worker safety awareness training.</u>
- Sec. 5. Any person employed by the Department of Health
- 24 and Human Services or by an entity contracting with the department
- 25 who provides direct social services or casework and is not licensed

- 1 <u>or certified under the Mental Health Practice Act shall complete no</u>
- 2 <u>fewer than six hours of social worker safety awareness training</u>
- 3 within the first thirty days of his or her employment by the
- 4 <u>department or such entity.</u>
- 5 Sec. 6. Original sections 28-310, 38-2101, and 38-2128,
- 6 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
