## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 744**

## Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county government; to amend section 23-1901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to authorize appointment of the county engineer in certain counties; to change powers and duties of the county engineer and county surveyor; to eliminate provisions related to election of the county engineer; to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal section 32-526, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 23-1901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 23-1901 (1) It shall be the duty of the county surveyor to make or
- 4 cause to be made all surveys within his or her county that the county
- 5 surveyor may be called upon to make and record the same.
- 6 (2)(a) (2) In all counties having a population of at least sixty
- 7 thousand inhabitants but less than one hundred fifty thousand
- 8 inhabitants, the county surveyor shall be ex officio county engineer and
- 9 shall be either a professional engineer as provided in the Engineers and
- 10 Architects Regulation Act or a registered land surveyor as provided in
- 11 the Land Surveyors Regulation Act or both. In such counties, the office
- 12 of surveyor shall be full time.
- 13 <u>(b)</u> In counties having a population of one hundred fifty thousand
- 14 inhabitants or more, the county board may appoint a county engineer. If a
- 15 <u>county engineer is appointed, the county engineer</u> shall be a professional
- 16 engineer as provided in the <u>Engineers and Architects Regulation Act</u> act
- 17 and shall be elected as provided in section 32-526.
- 18 (3) The county engineer, if one is appointed, or ex officio county
- 19 engineer shall:
- 20 (a) Prepare all plans, specifications, and detail drawings for the
- 21 use of the county in advertising and letting all contracts for the
- 22 building and repair of bridges, culverts, and all public improvements
- 23 upon the roads;
- 24 (b) Make estimates of the cost of all such contemplated public
- 25 improvements, make estimates of all material required for such public
- 26 improvements, inspect the material and have the same measured and
- 27 ascertained, and report to the county board whether the same is in
- 28 accordance with its requirements;
- 29 (c) Superintend the construction of all such public improvements and
- 30 inspect and require that the same shall be done according to contract;
- 31 (d) Make estimates of the cost of all labor and material which shall

- 1 be necessary for the construction of all bridges and improvements upon
- 2 public highways, inspect all of the work and materials placed in any such
- 3 public improvements, and make a report in writing to the county board
- 4 with a statement in regard to whether the same comply with the plans,
- 5 specifications, and detail drawings of the county board prepared for such
- 6 work or improvements and under which the contract was let; and
- 7 (e) Have charge and general supervision of work or improvements
- 8 authorized by the county board, inspect all materials, direct the work,
- 9 and make a report of each piece of work to the county board.
- 10 (4) The county engineer or surveyor shall also have such other and
- 11 further powers as are necessarily incident to the general powers granted.
- 12 (5) (4) The county surveyor shall prepare and file the required
- 13 annual inventory statement of county personal property in his or her
- 14 custody or possession as provided in sections 23-346 to 23-350.
- 15 (6) (5) In counties having a population of one hundred fifty
- 16 thousand inhabitants or more which have appointed a county engineer, the
- 17 county engineer shall appoint a full-time county surveyor. The county
- 18 surveyor shall perform all the duties prescribed in sections 23-1901 to
- 19 23-1913 and any other duties assigned to him or her by the county
- 20 engineer. The county surveyor shall be a registered land surveyor as
- 21 provided in the Land Surveyors Regulation Act.
- 22 Sec. 2. Original section 23-1901, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 23 Supplement, 2018, is repealed.
- 24 Sec. 3. The following section is outright repealed: Section 32-526,
- 25 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
