LEGISLATIVE BILL 802

Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Visitors Development Act; to
- 2 amend section 81-3701, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017; to create
- 3 a fund; to provide duties; to state intent; to harmonize provisions;
- 4 and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-3701, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is
2 amended to read:

3 81-3701 Sections 81-3701 to 81-3726 and sections 1 to 3 of this act
4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Visitors Development Act.

5 Sec. 2. Vendors under contract with the commission to develop,
6 print, and distribute publications and promotional materials on behalf of
7 the commission shall on a monthly basis submit to the commission all
8 revenue received from the sale of advertising space in such publications.
9 Monthly submissions shall include an itemization of the sources of
10 revenue in a format as designated by the commission. Revenue shall be
11 remitted to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Nebraska Tourism
12 Commission Promotional Cash Fund.

13 Sec. 3. The Nebraska Tourism Commission Promotional Cash Fund is
14 hereby created. The fund shall consist of revenue submitted by vendors as
15 designated under section 2 of this act. The commission shall use the fund
16 to carry out its purposes under the Nebraska Visitors Development Act.
17 Any money in the Nebraska Tourism Commission Promotional Cash Fund
18 available for investment shall be invested by the state investment
19 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
20 State Funds Investment Act.

21 Sec. 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that upon the effective
22 date of this act the balance existing in Fund 27212 shall be transferred
23 to the Nebraska Tourism Commission Promotional Cash Fund.

24 Sec. 5. Original section 81-3701, Revised Statutes Supplement,
25 2017, is repealed.
