6	Sec. 2. (1) For purposes of this section:
7	<u>(a) Child means any person who is under eighteen years of age or is</u>
8	currently enrolled in school or child care;
9	(b) Child care means child care, an early childhood education and
10	<u>assistance program, or a head start program;</u>
11	<u>(c) School means a public, private, denominational, or parochial</u>
12	school which meets the requirements for accreditation or approval
13	prescribed in Chapter 79;
14	<u>(d) School employee means anyone who works for a school or school</u>
15	district and includes, but is not limited to, a teacher, a substitute
16	teacher, classroom support staff, administrative staff, a
17	<u>paraprofessional, a counselor, a maintenance worker, a cafeteria worker,</u>
18	a custodian, a social worker, or a school nurse; and
19	<u>(e) School year means the period from and including the first day of</u>
20	the academic year to the last day of the academic year:
21	(i) For the school that employs the school employee;
22	(ii) For the school in which the child is enrolled as a student; or
23	<u>(iii) For a child in child care, for the school district in which</u>
24	the dwelling unit is located.
25	(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a tenant
26	shall not be evicted if:
27	<u>(a) The eviction would result in the tenant having to vacate the</u>
28	dwelling unit during the school year; and
29	(b) The tenant is any of the following:
30	<u>(i) A child;</u>
31	<u>(ii) A person having legal custody of a child, including, but not</u>

- limited to, the child's parent, step-parent, adoptive parent, guardian,
 foster parent, or custodian; or
 (iii) A school employee.
 (3) The prohibition in subsection (2) of this section does not apply
 if the action for possession or eviction is sought pursuant to subsection
 (4) of section 76-1431.
