- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-6,230, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to change a
- 3 provision relating to rotating or flashing lights; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-6,230, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
2 amended to read:

3 60-6,230 (1) Except as provided in this section and sections
4 60-6,231 to 60-6,233 and subsections (4) and (5) of this section, no
5 person shall operate any motor vehicle or any equipment of any
6 description on any highway in this state with any rotating or flashing
7 light.

8 (2) Except for stop lights and directional signals, which may be
9 red, yellow, or amber, no person shall display any color of light other
10 than red on the rear of any motor vehicle or any equipment of any kind on
11 any highway within this state.

12 (3) Amber rotating or flashing lights shall be displayed on vehicles
13 of the Military Department for purpose of convoy control when on any
14 state emergency mission.

15 (4) A single flashing white light may be displayed on the roof of
16 school transportation vehicles during extremely adverse weather
17 conditions.

18 (5) Blue and amber rotating or flashing lights may be displayed on
19 (a) ~~vehicles used for the movement of snow~~ when operated by the
20 Department of Roads or any local authority for the inspection,
21 construction, repair, or maintenance of highways, roads, or streets or
22 (b) vehicles owned and operated by any public utility for the
23 construction, maintenance, and repair of utility infrastructure on or
24 near any highway.
