7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 33-156 (1) In addition to all other court costs assessed according to law, an indigent defense fee of three dollars shall be 4 5 taxed as costs for each case filed in each county court and district 6 court, including appeals to such courts, and for each appeal and 7 original action filed in the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court. 8 The fees shall be remitted to the State Treasurer on forms prescribed by the State Treasurer within ten days after the end of the month. 9 10 The State Treasurer shall: credit 11 (a) Remit the indigent defense fees collected in any 12 county containing a city of the metropolitan class to the county treasurer of such county for credit to the indigent defense services 13 fund for such county; and 14 15 (b) Credit the remaining fees to the Commission on Public Advocacy Operations Cash Fund. 16 17 (2) In cases under the DNA Testing Act, costs shall be 18 paid as provided in such act. 19 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2012. 20 Sec. 3. Original section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed. 21 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 22 23 when passed and approved according to law.
