- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 84-612,
- 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013; to create a fund; to
- 3 transfer funds; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The Water Sustainability Fund is created. The

- 2 fund shall consist of transfers made by the Legislature and any
- 3 gifts, grants, bequests, or donations to the fund. Money in the fund
- 4 shall be used to fund programs, projects, and activities identified
- 5 by the Water Funding Task Force in its report under section 50-507.
- 6 The fund shall not be used for new capital projects. Any money in the
- 7 fund available for investment shall be invested by the state
- 8 investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and
- 9 <u>the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.</u>
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 11 2013, is amended to read:
- 12 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state
- 13 treasury a fund known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under
- 14 the direction of the State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used
- 15 pursuant to this section.
- 16 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the
- 17 Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the
- 18 Director of Administrative Services that the current cash balance in
- 19 the General Fund is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such
- 20 certification shall include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any
- 21 transfers made pursuant to this subsection shall be reversed upon
- 22 notification by the Director of Administrative Services that
- 23 sufficient funds are available.
- 24 (3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds,
- 25 the Cash Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the

1 State of Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes,

- 2 federal revenue sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.
- 3 (4) On July 7, 2009, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 4 five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Roads
- 5 Operations Cash Fund. The Department of Roads shall use such funds to
- 6 provide the required state match for federal funding made available
- 7 to the state through congressional earmarks.
- 8 (5) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of thirty-
- 9 seven million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund
- 10 on or before June 30, 2012, on such dates and in such amounts as
- 11 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 12 Department of Administrative Services.
- 13 (6) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of sixty-
- 14 eight million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund
- on or before June 30, 2013, on such dates and in such amounts as
- 16 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 17 Department of Administrative Services.
- 18 (7) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 19 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 20 Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed twelve million
- 21 dollars in total between July 1, 2011, and November 30, 2012, from
- 22 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund,
- 23 for ethanol production incentive credits, on such dates and in such
- 24 amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner.
- 25 (8) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget

1 administrator of the budget division of the Department of

- 2 Administrative Services, shall transfer an amount equal to the total
- 3 amount transferred pursuant to subsection (7) of this section from
- 4 the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund
- 5 in such amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner on or before
- 6 November 30, 2012.
- 7 (9) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 8 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 9 Administrative Services, shall transfer eighty million dollars from
- 10 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund on or
- 11 before August 15, 2012.
- 12 (10) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 13 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 14 Administrative Services, shall transfer one million dollars from the
- 15 Cash Reserve Fund to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund on or before
- 16 August 15, 2012.
- 17 (11) The State Treasurer shall transfer ten million
- 18 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund on or before
- 19 June 30, 2013, on such date as directed by the budget administrator
- 20 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.
- 21 (12) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
- 22 administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 23 Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed forty-three
- 24 million fifteen thousand four hundred fifty-nine dollars in total
- 25 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund

- 1 between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2017.
- 2 (13) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million
- 3 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Water Sustainability Fund
- 4 on or before July 31, 2014, on such dates and in such amounts as
- 5 <u>directed</u> by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 6 <u>Department of Administrative Services.</u>
