PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Murante, 49. Read first time January 05, 2017 Committee:

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2018, the following 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article I, section 22:

I-22 (1) All elections shall be free; and there shall be no
hindrance or impediment to the right of a qualified voter to exercise the
elective franchise.

(2) In order to combat voter fraud, preserve the relative power of 10 each eligible citizen's right to vote, modernize the election 11 infrastructure of the state, and ensure the integrity of the elections of 12 the state so as to preserve the public confidence in the legitimacy of 13 the elected government, each voter shall present identification that 14 contains a photograph or digital image of the voter prior to being able 15 to vote as provided by the Legislature. The Legislature shall provide 16 specifications for the identification and the manner of presentation and 17 for exemptions for specific situations in which requiring such 18 identification would violate an individual's rights under the 19 Constitution of the United States. 20

Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:
