AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDICIAL SALARIES; PROVIDING THAT JUSTICES OF THE STATE SUPREME COURT SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY INCREASE; PROVIDING THAT AN ANNUAL PAY INCREASE BE AT THE ANNUAL RATE OF INFLATION; REMOVING SALARY FORMULAS FOR MAGISTRATES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 34-1-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 278, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-1-9. SALARIES OF JUSTICES, JUDGES AND MAGISTRATES.--

A. Justices of the supreme court shall each receive an annual salary ~~[as provided by the legislature]~~ of two hundred thirty-two thousand six hundred dollars (\$232,600) beginning July 1, 2024, and salaries thereafter shall increase annually at the rate of inflation as measured by the consumer

1 price index. The chief justice of the supreme court shall
2 receive an annual salary that is two thousand dollars (\$2,000)
3 more than the annual salary of a justice of the supreme court.

4 B. The chief judge of:

5 (1) the court of appeals shall receive an
6 annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary
7 of the chief justice of the supreme court;

8 (2) a district court shall receive an annual
9 salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary of the
10 chief judge of the court of appeals; and

11 (3) a metropolitan court shall receive an
12 annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary
13 of the chief judge of a district court.

14 ~~[C. The presiding magistrate of a magistrate~~

16 ~~court shall receive an annual salary that is seventy-five~~

17 fiscal years, the annual salary for justices of the supreme
18 court, judges of the court of appeals, district court judges,

22 [~~F.~~] E. No additional salaries shall be paid to
23 justices, judges or magistrates on account of services rendered

1 and magistrates shall receive per diem and mileage for
2 necessary travel on official business of the court as provided
3 in the Per Diem and Mileage Act."

4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--Six million forty-eight
5 thousand six hundred eighty-four dollars (\$6,048,684) is
6 appropriated from the general fund to the administrative office
7 of the courts for expenditure in fiscal year 2025 and
8 subsequent fiscal years to fund judicial salaries. Any
9 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a
10 fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.
