11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE NEW MEXICO GROWN FRESH
12 FRUITS AND VEGETABLES FOR SCHOOL MEALS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million four hundred forty
16 thousand dollars (\$1,440,000) is appropriated from the general
17 fund to the public education department for expenditure in
18 fiscal year 2015 and subsequent fiscal years for the public
19 education department to distribute to school districts and
20 charter schools for the purchase of New Mexico grown fresh
21 fruits and vegetables for school meal programs. The public
22 education department, in coordination with the New Mexico
23 department of agriculture, shall ensure that the appropriated
24 funds are expended for the stated purpose. Any unexpended or
25 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year
