19	A. The "public education data advisory council" is

The department shall provide the council any 13 data, calculations or related information, such as mathematical 14 formulas, used in the calculations of school grades and 15 educator evaluations upon request of the council; provided, 16 however, that any student- or teacher-level information 17 18 reviewed by the council shall remain confidential. 19 D. The council shall report to the legislative 20 education study committee and the legislative finance committee at their December meetings on the accuracy and validity of data 21 and calculations used for school grades and teacher evaluations 22 and on any recommendations for the department or the 23 legislature. 24 - 2 -25
