RELATING TO TAXATION; PROVIDING A GROSS RECEIPTS TAX AND A GOVERNMENTAL GROSS RECEIPTS TAX DEDUCTION FOR MEDICAL CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 7-9-73.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1998, Chapter 95, Section 2 and Laws 1998, Chapter 99, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

"7-9-73.2. DEDUCTION--GROSS RECEIPTS [TAX] AND
GOVERNMENTAL GROSS RECEIPTS [TAX]--PRESCRIPTION DRUGS--OXYGEN
AND OXYGEN SERVICES--MEDICAL CANNABIS.--

A. Receipts from the sale of prescription drugs

[and oxygen and oxygen services provided by a licensed medicare

durable medical equipment provider] may be deducted from gross

receipts and governmental gross receipts.
