H. "treasury" means the master depository or cash concentration account held at the state's fiscal agent bank and administered by the office of the state treasurer, unless the context otherwise clearly indicates; and

9 I. "tribe" means a federally recognized Indian 10 nation, tribe or pueblo or a subdivision or agency of a 11 federally recognized Indian nation, tribe or pueblo, located 12 wholly or partially in New Mexico."

SECTION 2. Section 6-10-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1923, Chapter 76, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"6-10-3. PAYMENT OF STATE MONEY INTO TREASURY--SUSPENSE 15 FUNDS.--All public money in the custody or under the control 16 of any state official or agency obtained or received by any 17 official or agency from any source, except as in Section 18 6-10-54 NMSA 1978 provided, shall be paid into the state 19 20 treasury. It is the duty of every official or person in charge of any state agency receiving any money in cash or by 21 check, draft or otherwise for or on behalf of the state or 22 any agency thereof from any source, except as in Section 23 6-10-54 NMSA 1978 provided, to forthwith and before the close 24 of the next succeeding business day after the receipt of the 25

SB 278 Page 2 1 money to deliver or remit it to the state treasurer; 2 provided, however, that:

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A. the money collected by the state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural resources department and the state monuments division of the cultural affairs department shall be deposited into the state treasury no later than ten days following collection;

B. county treasurers shall remit all money
9 received for taxes for state purposes or that are by law
10 required to be remitted to the department on or before the
11 tenth day of the next succeeding month following the receipt
12 or collection thereof;

C. every official or person in charge of any state 13 agency receiving any money, except as in Section 6-10-54 NMSA 14 15 1978 provided, in cash or by check or draft, on deposit, in escrow or in evidence of good faith to secure the performance 16 of any contract or agreement with the state or with any 17 department, institution or agency of the state, which money 18 has not yet been earned so as to become the absolute property 19 20 of the state, shall deliver or remit to the state treasury within the times and in the manner as in this section 21 provided, which money shall be deposited in a suspense 22 account to the credit of the proper official, person, board 23 or bureau in charge of any state agency so receiving the 24 money; and 25

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1 D. all money held by the commissioner of public 2 lands on deposit, in escrow or in evidence of good faith to 3 secure the performance of any contract or agreement with the state shall be delivered or remitted to the state treasury 4 5 within six months from the date this act is approved and at 6 those times, in the amounts and from the various banks in which it is deposited as may be directed by the state board 7 of finance." 8 SECTION 3. Section 8-6-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 9 10 1851-1852, Page 170, as amended) is amended to read: "8-6-3. DUTIES OF TREASURER--RECEIPTS.--The state 11 treasurer shall receive and keep all money of the state 12 except when otherwise specially provided; disburse the public 13 money upon warrants drawn according to law and not otherwise; 14 15 keep a just, true and comprehensive account of all money received and disbursed; render the state treasurer's accounts 16 to the financial control division of the department of 17 finance and administration annually, or more often if 18 required; and report to the legislature, at the commencement 19 20 of each regular session, a detailed statement of the condition of the treasury. The state treasury shall grant 21 duplicate receipts for all money paid into the treasury, and 22 the person receiving the duplicate receipts shall record the 23 entry in the centralized accounting system administered by 24 the department of finance and administration." 25
