AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; REQUIRING THAT THE BRAIN INJURY SERVICES FEE BE MANDATORY FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989, Chapter 318, Section 35 and Laws 1989, Chapter 319, Section 14 and also Laws 1989, Chapter 320, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-8-116.3. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--ADDITIONAL FEES.--In addition to the penalty assessment established for each penalty assessment misdemeanor, there shall be assessed:

- A. in a county without a metropolitan court, twenty dollars (\$20.00) to help defray the costs of local government corrections;
- B. a court automation fee of ten dollars (\$10.00);
