SUMMARY—Enacts provisions to assist veteran-owned businesses to create cooperatives. (BDR 7-288)

AN ACT relating to veterans; authorizing a cooperative entity to use certain words in the name of the cooperative if a certain number of the directors or members of the cooperative are veterans; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, a person may form various types of cooperative entities. Existing law authorizes three or more persons to form a nonprofit cooperative corporation. (NRS 81.010-81.160) Existing law authorizes five or more persons to form a cooperative association. (NRS 81.170-81.270) Under existing law, three or more persons may form a nonprofit cooperative corporation without stock. (NRS 81.410-81.540) This bill authorizes any of these types of cooperative entities to include the words "veteran-owned cooperative" in the name of the cooperative only if: (1) 51 percent of the directors of the cooperative are veterans; or (2) 51 percent of the members of the cooperative are veterans. This bill also provides that a veteran-owned cooperative has the same rights as any other entity or business formed in this State.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Chapter 81 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A cooperative entity formed pursuant to this chapter may include the words "veteran-owned cooperative" in the name of the cooperative entity only if:
- (a) At least 51 percent of the directors of the cooperative entity are veterans; or
- (b) At least 51 percent of the members of the cooperative entity are veterans.
- 2. A cooperative entity formed pursuant to this chapter which includes the words "veteran-owned cooperative" in the name of the cooperative entity pursuant to subsection 1 has the same rights as any other entity or business formed in this State, including, without limitation, the rights to submit a bid on a public project or apply for a license or certification.
- 3. As used in this section, "veteran" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 417.005.
  - **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
