Sec. 5101.85. As used in sections 5101.851 to 5101.853	14
5101.856 of the Revised Code, "kinship caregiver" means any of	15
the following who is eighteen years of age or older and is	16
caring for a child in place of the child's parents:	17

"great," "great-great," or "great-great-great";	21
