A BILL

То	amend section 4503.29 of the Revised Code to	1
	allow an applicant for a military license plate	2
	to present a county-issued veterans	3
	identification card as evidence of an honorable	4
	discharge.	5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4503.29 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7
Sec. 4503.29. (A) The director of veterans services in	8
conjunction with the registrar of motor vehicles shall develop	9
and maintain a program to establish and issue nonstandard	10
license plates recognizing military service and military honors	11
pertaining to valor and service.	12
(B) The director and the registrar shall jointly adopt	13
rules in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code for	14
purposes of establishing the program under this section. The	15
director and registrar shall adopt the rules as soon as possible	16

after June 29, 2018, but not later than nine months after June	17
29, 2018. The rules shall do all of the following:	18
(1) Establish nonstandard license plates recognizing	19
military service;	20
milital, service,	20
(2) Establish nonstandard license plates recognizing	21
military honors pertaining to valor and service;	
(3) Establish eligibility criteria that apply to each	23
nonstandard license plate issued under this section;	24
(4) Establish requirements governing any necessary	25
documentary evidence required to be presented by an applicant	26
for a nonstandard license plate issued under this section+.The	27
rules shall allow an applicant to present a veterans	28
identification card issued in accordance with section 317.241 of	29
the Revised Code in lieu of a copy of the applicant's DD-214 or	30
an equivalent document. An applicant may be required to present	31
additional evidence if the veterans identification card does not	32
show all of the information needed for issuance of the specific	33
nonstandard license plate requested by the applicant.	34
(5) Establish guidelines for the designs, markings, and	35
inscriptions on a nonstandard license plate established under	36
this section;	37
(6) Establish procedures for altering the designs,	38
markings, or inscriptions on a nonstandard license plate	39
established under this section;	40
(7) Prohibit nonstandard license plates established under	41
this section from recognizing achievement awards or unit awards;	42
(8) Establish any other procedures or requirements that	43
are necessary for the implementation and administration of this	44

section.	45
(C) The rules adopted under division (B) of this section	46
shall provide for the establishment of the military nonstandard	47
license plates created under sections 4503.431, 4503.432,	48
4503.433, 4503.434, 4503.436, 4503.48, 4503.481, 4503.53,	49
4503.532, 4503.533, 4503.536, 4503.537, 4503.538, 4503.54,	50
4503.541, 4503.543, 4503.544, 4503.547, 4503.548, 4503.581,	51
4503.59, and 4503.731 of the Revised Code as those sections	52
existed prior to June 29, 2018.	53
(D)(1) Any person who meets the applicable qualifications	54
for the issuance of a nonstandard license plate established by	55
rule adopted under division (B) of this section may apply to the	56
registrar of motor vehicles for the registration of any	57
passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational	58
vehicle, or other vehicle the person owns or leases of a class	59
approved by the registrar. The application may be combined with	
a request for a special reserved license plate under section	
4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code.	62
(2)(a) Except as provided in division (D)(2)(b) of this	63
section, upon receipt of an application for registration of a	64
motor vehicle under this section and the required taxes and	65
fees, compliance with all applicable laws relating to the	66
registration of a motor vehicle, and, if necessary, upon	67
presentation of the required documentary evidence, the registrar	68
shall issue to the applicant the appropriate motor vehicle	69
registration and a set of license plates and a validation	70
sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required by section	71
4503.191 of the Revised Code.	72
(b) Any disabled veteran who qualifies to apply to the	73
registrar for the registration of a motor vehicle under section	74

4503.41 of the Revised Code without the payment of any	75
registration taxes or fees, may apply instead for registration	76
of the motor vehicle under this section. The disabled veteran	77
applying for registration under this section is not required to	78
pay any registration taxes or fees as required by sections	79
4503.038, 4503.04, 4503.10, 4503.102, and 4503.103 of the	80
Revised Code, any local motor vehicle tax levied under Chapter	81
4504. of the Revised Code, or any fee charged under section	82
4503.19 of the Revised Code for up to two motor vehicles,	83
including any motor vehicle registered under section 4503.41 of	84
the Revised Code. Upon receipt of an application for	85
registration of the motor vehicle and presentation of any	86
documentation the registrar may require by rule, the registrar	87
shall issue to the applicant the appropriate motor vehicle	88
registration and a set of license plates authorized under this	89
section and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone	90
when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.	91
(3) The license plates shall display county identification	92
stickers that identify the county of registration as required	93
under section 4503.19 of the Revised Code.	94
(E) Sections 4503.77 and 4503.78 of the Revised Code do	95
not apply to license plates issued under this section.	96
Section 2. That existing section 4503.29 of the Revised	97

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Code is hereby repealed.
