BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3337.01, 3339.01, 3341.02, 10 3343.02, 3343.06, 3344.01, 3350.10, 3352.01, 3356.01, 3359.01, 11 3361.01, 3362.01, and 3364.01 of the Revised Code be amended to 12 read as follows: 13 Sec. 3337.01. (A) The body politic and corporate by the 14 name and style of "The President and Trustees of the Ohio 15 University" now in the university instituted and established in 16 Athens by the name and style of "The Ohio University" shall 17 consist of a board of trustees composed of eleven members, who 18

shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate. At least five of the trustees who are not students shall be graduates of Ohio university. Two of the trustees shall be students at Ohio university, and their selection and terms shall be in accordance with division (B) of this section. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum. Except for the terms of student members, terms of office shall

25 Except for the terms of student members, terms of office shall be for nine years, commencing on the fourteenth day of May and 26 ending on the thirteenth day of May, except that upon expiration 27 of the term ending on May 14, 1978, the new term which succeeds 28 it shall commence on May 15, 1978, and end on May 13, 1987. Each 29 member shall hold office from the date of appointment until the 30 end of the term for which the member was appointed. Any member 31 appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of 32 the term for which the member's predecessor was appointed shall 33 hold office for the remainder of such term. Any member shall 34 continue in office subsequent to the expiration date of the 35 member's term until the member's successor takes office, or 36 until a period of sixty days has elapsed, whichever occurs 37 first. Sec. 3339.01. (A) The government of Miami university shall 97 be vested in eleven trustees, who shall be appointed by the 98 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate. Two of the 99 trustees shall be students at Miami university, and their 100 selection and terms shall be in accordance with division (B) of 101 this section. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum. 102 Except for the terms of student members, terms of office shall 103 be for nine years, commencing on the first day of March and 104 ending on the last day of February, except that upon expiration 105 of the trustee term ending on March 1, 1974, the trustee term 106 which succeeds it shall commence on March 2, 1974, and end on 107 February 28, 1983; upon expiration of the trustee term ending on 108 March 1, 1977, the trustee term which succeeds it shall commence 109

(A) The government of Bowling Green state 182 university is vested in a board of eleven trustees, who shall be 183 appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the 184 senate. Two of the trustees shall be students at Bowling Green 185 state university, and their selection and terms shall be in 186 accordance with division (B) of this section. A majority of the 187 board constitutes a quorum. Except for the terms of student 188 members, terms of office shall be for nine years, commencing on 189 the seventeenth day of May and ending on the sixteenth day of 190 May. No person who has served a full nine-year term or more than 191 six years of such a term shall be eligible for reappointment 192 until a period of four years has elapsed since the last day of 193 the term for which the person previously served. 194

the practice of medicine at the community level, especially

family physicians. To accomplish this goal, the medical 499 university may incorporate in the clinical experience provided 500 its students the several community hospitals in the cities and 501 areas served by the medical university; utilize practicing 502 physicians as teachers; and to the fullest extent possible 503 utilize the basic science capabilities of the university of 504 505 Akron, Cleveland state university, Kent state university, and 506 Youngstown state university.

(1) Until December 22, 2008, the government of the 507 508 northeast Ohio medical university is vested in a nine-member board of trustees consisting of the presidents of the university 509 of Akron, Kent state university, and Youngstown state 510 university; one member each of the boards of trustees of the 511 university of Akron, Kent state university, and Youngstown state 512 university, to be appointed by their respective boards of 513 trustees for a term of six years ending on the first day of May 514 or until the trustee's term on the respective university board 515 of trustees expires, whichever occurs first; and one person each 516 to be appointed by the boards of trustees of the university of 517 Akron, Kent state university, and Youngstown state university, 518 for a term of nine years ending on the first day of May; except 519 that the term of those first appointed by the several boards of 520 trustees shall expire on the first day of May next following 521 their appointment. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired 522 term in the manner provided for original appointment. The terms of office of the sixteen other voting members of1063the initial board of trustees shall expire on July 1 of the year1064they otherwise would expire under former section 3350.01 or10653360.01 of the Revised Code.1066

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July10671, 2007, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the1068advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to1069the office of the other voting member whose term expires on that1070

date to a nine-year term beginning on July 2, 2007. 1071

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July 1077 1, 2009, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the 1078 advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to 1079 the office of the other voting member whose term expires on that 1080 date to a nine-year term beginning on July 2, 2009. 1081

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July10821, 2010, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the1083advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to1084the office of the other voting member whose term expires on that1085date to a nine-year term beginning on July 2, 2010.1086

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July 1087 1, 2011, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the 1088 advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to 1089 the office of the other voting member whose term expires on that 1090 date to a nine-year term beginning on July 2, 2011. 1091

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July 1092 1, 2012, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the 1093 advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to 1094 the office of the other voting member whose term expires on that 1095 date to a nine-year term beginning on July 2, 2012. 1096

The office of one voting member whose term expires on July10971, 2013, shall be abolished on that date. The governor, with the1098advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor to1099

(3) The student members of the board of trustees of the 1131 combined university shall be appointed by the governor, with the 1132 advice and consent of the senate, from a group of six candidates 1133 selected pursuant to a procedure adopted by the university's 1134 student governments and approved by the university's board of 1135 trustees. Terms of office of student members shall be for two 1136 years, each term ending on the same day of the same month of the 1137 year as the term it succeeds. In the event that a student member 1138 1139 cannot fulfill a two-year term, a replacement shall be selected to fill the unexpired term in the same manner used to make the 1140 original selection. <u>Unless the student members of the board have</u> 1141 been granted voting power under division (D) of this section, 1142 they shall have no voting power, shall not be considered members 1143 of the board in determining whether a quorum is present, and 1144 shall not be entitled to attend executive sessions of the board. 1145

(4) Each trustee shall hold office from the date of 1146 appointment until the end of the term for which the trustee was 1147 appointed. Any trustee appointed to fill a vacancy occurring 1148 prior to the expiration of the term for which the trustee's 1149 predecessor was appointed shall hold office for the remainder of 1150 such term. Any trustee shall continue in office subsequent to 1151 the expiration date of the trustee's term until the trustee's 1152 successor takes office, or until a period of sixty days has 1153 elapsed, whichever occurs first. 1154

(5) No person who has served as a voting member of the
board of trustees for a full nine-year term or more than six
years of such a term and no person who is a voting member of the
initial board of trustees as prescribed in division (B) (2) (a) of
this section is eligible for reappointment to the board until a

period of four years has elapsed since the last day of the term	1160

(C) The trustees shall receive no compensation for their	1173
services but shall be paid their reasonable necessary expenses	1174
while engaged in the discharge of their official duties. A	1175
majority of the board constitutes a quorum. The student members	1176
of the board have no voting power on the board. Student members-	1177
shall not be considered as members of the board in determining	1178
whether a quorum is present. Student members shall not be-	1179
entitled to attend executive sessions of the board.	1180
(D) Not later than ninety days after the effective date of	1181
this amendment, the board of trustees shall adopt a resolution	1182
that does one of the following:	1183
(1) Grants the student members of the board voting power	1184
on the board. If so granted, in addition to having voting power,	1185

in determining whether a quorum is present and shall be entitled	1187
