BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.646 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 5534.646. (A) In addition to any other name	7
prescribed in the Revised Code or otherwise, all of the	8
following shall be known as the "Brigadier General Charles Young	9
Memorial Historical Corridor":	10
(1) The northeastbound and southwestbound lanes of United	11
States route number forty-two between the intersection of United	12
States route number forty-two and campus drive and the	13

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intersection of United States route number forty-two and United	14
States route number sixty-eight in Greene county;	
(2) The northbound and southbound lanes of United States	16
route number sixty-eight between the intersection of that route	17
and United States route number forty-two in Greene county and	18
the intersection of United States route number sixty-eight and	
United States route number sixty-two in Brown county;	20
(3) The northbound and southbound lanes of United States	21
route number sixty-two between the intersection of that route	22
and United States route number sixty-eight and the Simon Kenton	
bridge in Brown county.	24
(B) The director of transportation may erect suitable	25
markers along the highways indicating their name.	26
