## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 6301.22 of the Revised Code be	5		
enacted to read as follows:			
Sec. 6301.22. (A) With regard to industry-recognized	7		
credentials and certificate programs, the governor's office of	8		
workforce transformation shall act as a liaison between the			
business community and the department of education or the	10		

chancellor of higher education. In acting as a liaison, the	11		
governor's office of workforce transformation shall accept	12		
inquiries from the business community regarding all of the	13		
following:	14		
(1) Industry-recognized credentials approved under section	15		
3313.6113 of the Revised Code;	16		
(2) Certificate programs and industry-recognized	17		
credentials included in the inventory prescribed under section	18		
3333.94 of the Revised Code;	19		
(3) Any other existing or proposed credential or	20		
certificate program necessary to meet the workforce needs of the	21		
state, as determined by the office.	22		
(B) Based on inquiries submitted under division (A) of	23		
this section, the governor's office of workforce transformation	24		
shall do either of the following:	25		
(1) Request information from the department of education	26		
regarding industry-recognized credentials approved under section	27		
3313.6113 of the Revised Code;	28		
(2) Request information from the chancellor regarding	29		
certificate programs and industry-recognized credentials	30		
included in the inventory prescribed under section 3333.94 of	31		
the Revised Code or offered by an institution that holds a	32		
certificate of authorization issued under Chapter 1713. of the	33		
Revised Code.	34		
(C) Based on inquiries submitted under division (A) of	35		
this section, the governor's office of workforce transformation,			
in collaboration with the department of education, the	37		
chancellor, and other stakeholders, including regional education	38		
providers, determined appropriate by the office, shall convene a	39		

review of an existing or proposed industry-recognized credential	40
or certificate program. The office shall submit the findings of	41
the department of education or the chancellor, as appropriate,	42
to the business that submitted the inquiry for which the review	43
was initiated.	44
(D) Nothing in this section shall affect the	45
responsibilities assigned under division (B) of section	46
3313.6113 of the Revised Code to the committee established under	47
division (A) of that section or the responsibilities assigned to	48
the chancellor under division (B) of section 3333.94 of the	49
Revised Code.	50

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
