A BILL

To amend section 4513.17 of the Revised Code to	1
clarify that a motorcycle may have a modulating	2
headlight that meets federal standards.	3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4513.17 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4513.17. (A) Whenever a motor vehicle equipped with	6
headlights also is equipped with any auxiliary lights or	7
spotlight or any other light on the front thereof projecting a	8
beam of an intensity greater than three hundred candle power,	9
not more than a total of five of any such lights on the front of	10
a vehicle shall be lighted at any one time when the vehicle is	11
upon a highway.	12
(B) Any lighted light or illuminating device upon a motor	13
vehicle, other than headlights, spotlights, signal lights, or	14
auxiliary driving lights, that projects a beam of light of an	15
intensity greater than three hundred candle power, shall be so	16
directed that no part of the beam will strike the level of the	17
roadway on which the vehicle stands at a distance of more than	18

seventy-five feet from the vehicle.

(C) (1) Flashing lights are prohibited on motor vehicles,
except as a means for indicating a right or a left turn, or in
the presence of a vehicular traffic hazard requiring unusual
care in approaching, or overtaking or passing. This

(2) The prohibition established in division (C) (1) of this24section does not apply to emergency any of the following:25

26 (a) Emergency vehicles, road service vehicles servicing or towing a disabled vehicle, stationary waste collection vehicles 27 actively collecting garbage, refuse, trash, or recyclable 28 materials on the roadside, rural mail delivery vehicles, 29 vehicles as provided in section 4513.182 of the Revised Code, 30 highway maintenance vehicles, funeral hearses, funeral escort 31 vehicles, and similar equipment operated by the department or 32 local authorities, which shall be provided such vehicles are 33 equipped with and display, when used on a street or highway for 34 the special purpose necessitating such lights, a flashing, 35 oscillating, or rotating amber light, but shall not display a 36 flashing, oscillating, or rotating light of any other color, nor 37 to vehicles; 38

(b) Vehicles or machinery permitted by section 4513.11 of 39 the Revised Code to have a flashing red light-; 40

(2) When used on a street or highway, farm (c) Farm41machinery and vehicles escorting farm machinery may be, provided42such machinery and vehicles are equipped with and display, when43used on a street or highway, a flashing, oscillating, or44rotating amber light, and the prohibition contained in division45(C) (1) of this section does not apply to such machinery or46vehicles. Farm machinery also may display the lights described47

in section 4513.11 of the Revised Code.

(D) (1) Except a person operating a public safety vehicle, 49 as defined in division (E) of section 4511.01 of the Revised 50 Code, or a school bus, no person shall operate, move, or park 51 upon, or permit to stand within the right-of-way of any public 52 street or highway any vehicle or equipment that is equipped with 53 and displaying a flashing red or a flashing combination red and 54 white light, or an oscillating or rotating red light, or a 55 combination red and white oscillating or rotating light; and 56 57 except_.

(2) Except a public law enforcement officer, or other person sworn to enforce the criminal and traffic laws of the state, operating a public safety vehicle when on duty, no person shall operate, move, or park upon, or permit to stand within the right-of-way of any street or highway any vehicle or equipment that is equipped with, or upon which is mounted, and displaying a flashing blue or a flashing combination blue and white light, or an oscillating or rotating blue light, or a combination blue and white oscillating or rotating light.

(E) This section does not prohibit the use of warning any of the following:

(1) The warning lights required by law or the simultaneous flashing of turn signals on disabled vehicles or on vehicles being operated in unfavorable atmospheric conditions in order to enhance their visibility. This section also does not prohibit the;

(2) The simultaneous flashing of turn signals or warning74lights either on farm machinery or vehicles escorting farm75machinery, when used on a street or highway;76
