To enact section 109.96 of the Revised Code to	1
establish a database of records of use of force	2
by law enforcement officers.	3

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 109.96 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 109.96. (A) The attorney general shall establish and	6
maintain a database of records of use of force by law	7
<u>enforcement officers.</u>	8
(B) A law enforcement agency shall submit a record of a	9
law enforcement officer's use of force to the attorney general	10
if any of the following occur:	11
(1) A law enforcement officer's use of force results in	12
the death of a person.	13
(2) A law enforcement officer's use of force results in	14
<u>serious bodily injury to a person.</u>	15

(3) A law enforcement officer discharges a firearm at or	16
in the direction of a person.	17
(C) Upon receiving records pursuant to division (B) of	18
this section, the attorney general shall do all of the	19
following:	20
(1) Analyze the records of use of force by law enforcement	21
officers;	22
(2) Publish the analysis of records of use of force by law	23
enforcement officers in an annual report;	24
(3) Distribute copies of the annual report to the general	25
assembly.	26
(D) The attorney general shall adopt rules in accordance	27
with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code governing the	28
establishment, operation, and maintenance of the database of	29
records of use of force by law enforcement officers.	30
