A BILL

To terminate the COVID-19 state of emergency in 1
Ohio and to declare an emergency. 2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 5502. of the Revised 3
Code, the General Assembly hereby terminates the state of 4
emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-01D, issued on March 5
9, 2020. 6

Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency 7
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 8
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that 9
having a state of emergency for COVID-19 in effect for a 10
prolonged period of time, including when the reason for such 11
emergency no longer exists, harms the well-being of Ohio's 12
citizens and businesses. Therefore, this act shall go into 13
immediate effect. 14
