BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4765.401 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4765.401. (A) The (1) Not later than ninety days	6
after the effective date of this amendment, the state board of	7
emergency medical, fire, and transportation services shall	8
develop guidelines for the assessment, triage, and transport to	9
hospitals of stroke patients by emergency medical service	10
personnel. The board shall make the guidelines available on the	11
internet web site maintained by the board. The board shall	12
review the guidelines periodically and update them as needed. If	13
the board updates the guidelines, the board shall make the	14
updated versions available on the web site it maintains. The	15
board may distribute the guidelines and their updated versions	16
in any other manner acceptable to the board.	17
(2) Based on the guidelines developed under division (A)	18
(1) of this section and not later than one hundred eighty days	19

after the effective date of this amendment, the medical director	20
or cooperating physician advisory board of each emergency	21
medical service organization shall establish written protocols	22
for the assessment, treatment, and transport to hospitals of	23
stroke patients by emergency medical service personnel. In <u>When</u>	24
establishing protocols, the medical director or cooperating	25
physician advisory board shall consult with one or more local	26
hospitals.	27
(B) Each (1) The medical director or cooperating physician	28
<u>advisory board of each emergency medical service organization</u>	29
shall provide copies of its protocols <u>annually</u> to the state	30
board of emergency medical, fire, and transportation services;	31
the department of health; and the regional director or regional	32
advisory board appointed under section 4765.05 of the Revised	33
Code for the organization's emergency medical services region.	34
(2) The state board of emergency medical, fire, and	35
transportation services shall make available to the public	36
copies of the protocols submitted under division (B)(1) of this	37
section.	38
(C) The medical director or cooperating physician advisory	39
board of each emergency medical service organization shall	40
provide periodically to its emergency medical service personnel	41
training in the assessment and treatment of stroke patients. The	42
training shall address large vessel occlusion.	43
