8 An Act relating to schools; providing for increase in  
9 compensation of certain support employees;  
10 prescribing amount of increase; providing increase in  
11 compensation as additional to certain other  
12 compensation and fringe benefits; providing for pro  
13 rata computation; providing for codification;  
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.42 of Title 70, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. For the 2018-19 school year, each school district shall  
21 provide to every support employee a wage increase over the base  
22 amount the employee earned during the 2017-18 school year if the  
23 support employee is employed by the same school district for the  
24 2018-19 school year in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty  
Dollars (\$1,250.00). The dollar amount of salary increase  
authorized by this subsection shall be prorated based upon the

1 number of total hours of work performed by a full-time equivalent  
2 support employee.

3 B. The increase prescribed by this section shall be in addition  
4 to any other compensation and fringe benefits provided by the  
5 district, or mandated by law or collective bargaining agreement,  
6 unless the hours or duties of the support employee are reduced  
7 proportionately.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
