NEW LAW 14 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 555.1 of Title 57, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The Department of Corrections is authorized to negotiate and 17 enter into a water purchase agreement and execute necessary 18 easements with a public nonprofit rural water district organized 19 under the Rural Water, Sewer, Gas and Solid Waste Management 20 Districts Act for purposes of selling at cost groundwater found 21 beneath real property owned by the Department, on which the 22 Lexington Assessment and Reception Center and the Joseph Harp 23 Correctional Center at Lexington, Oklahoma, are located, and for 24

2	permit the Department holds from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board
3	to allow for use as a public water supply. The term of the water
4	purchase agreement and easement shall be for not less than forty

7	entered into for the sale of water shall include a reserved right of
8	usage by the Oklahoma Department of Corrections.
9	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
