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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 82, O.S.L. 2016
14	(40 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 405.1), is amended to read as follows:
15	Section 405.1 $\underline{A}$ . There is hereby created in the State Treasury
16	a revolving fund for the Department of Labor to be designated the
17	"Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund". The
18	fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
19	limitations, and shall consist of all administrative fines collected
20	by the Department for violations of the Oklahoma Occupational Health
21	and Safety Standards Act and the Oklahoma Asbestos Control Act, and
22	any rules promulgated thereto. All monies accruing to the credit of
23	the fund, except those monies specified in subsection B of this
24	section, are hereby directed to be transferred by the Commissioner

Τ	of Labor to the State Treasurer for deposit and credit to the
2	General Revenue Fund at the end of each fiscal year.
3	B. The Department of Labor shall retain up to Thirty Thousand
4	Dollars (\$30,000.00) of monies accruing to the credit of the
5	Department of Labor Administrative Penalty Revolving Fund, derived
6	from citations for violations of the Oklahoma Occupational Health
7	and Safety Standards Act, per fiscal year. Said monies shall only
8	be used in support of this act for the production and dissemination
9	of workplace safety educational materials, for workplace safety
10	educational presentations and training, or for the acquisition of
11	workplace safety equipment, to be provided by the Department of
12	Labor, at its discretion, to employers as defined in Section 402 of
13	this title. Said monies shall not be expended for Department of
14	Labor employee salaries or benefits or for Department of Labor
15	administrative costs.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
