An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 661.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 2016 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 661.1), which relates to positions subject to the merit system; modifying exceptions; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Positions subject to the merit system

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 661.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 2016 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 661.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 661.1 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, all positions of the Office of the Secretary of State are subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration.

- B. The following positions of the Office of the Secretary of State shall be in the unclassified service:
 - 1. The Secretary of State;
 - 2. The Assistant Secretary of State;
 - 3. The Chief Financial Officer; and
 - 4. The Deputy Assistant of Native American Affairs; and
 - 5. One Executive Secretary Administrative Officers.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
