18	Section 4210.3 It shall be unlawful to transport a shotgun,
19	rifle or pistol in or to discharge such weapons <u>a firearm</u> from a
20	vessel, except for the purposes of <u>self-defense,</u> hunting animals or
21	fowl, and in compliance with existing state and federal laws.
22	Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,
23	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
24	not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred

1	Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
2	less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6) three (3) months,
3	or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person in possession of

5	authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not be deemed
6	guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this section when a
7	handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or about their
8	person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-
9	Defense Act.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
