12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 8-115, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 8-115. The counting of ballots shall continue without
16	pause until all votes have been tabulated. If extreme and
17	unforeseen circumstances occur that require suspension of the vote
18	count, election officials shall notify the public of the suspension
19	and the exact time that the vote count will resume. When all the
20	ballots have been counted, the county election board shall tabulate
21	the votes and shall certify the results. In the case of county
22	office, said certification shall be used to issue appropriate lists
23	and certificates. In the case of state or district office, copies
24	of said certification shall be transmitted immediately to the State

Election Board, whose duty it shall be to retabulate all pertinent county returns and issue appropriate lists and certificates.

In the event of a tie involving candidates, the election board authorized by law to issue the certified list or certificate of

election shall, at the meeting called to conduct the recount or to issue the certified list or certificate of election, in the presence of the candidates involved, if they or any of them desire to be

present, select the nominee or electee by lot substantially as prescribed in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Section 8-105 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
