The punishment of death shall be carried out 20 by the: 2.1 1. The administration of a lethal quantity of a drug or drugs 22 until death is pronounced by a licensed physician according to 23 accepted standards of medical practice.

B. If the execution of the sentence of death as provided in subsection A of this section is held unconstitutional by an appellate court of competent jurisdiction or is otherwise unavailable, then the sentence of death shall be carried out by nitrogen;

- C. If the execution of the sentence of death as provided in subsections A and B of this section is held unconstitutional by an appellate court of competent jurisdiction or is otherwise unavailable, then the sentence of death shall be carried out by electrocution.
- D. If the execution of the sentence of death as provided in subsections A, B and C of this section is held unconstitutional by an appellate court of competent jurisdiction or is otherwise unavailable, then the sentence of death shall be carried out by firing;
 - 3. Firing squad; or
- 4. When the above methods are unavailable, any method not prohibited by the United States Constitution.

The manner of carrying out the punishment of death shall be selected by the Director of the Department of Corrections. Notice of the selected manner of carrying out the punishment shall be given to the convicted inmate as provided by policy of the Department of Corrections.
